The Children's Trust Fund was created by State statute in 1978. Our mission is to provide funds for the development of innovative and pioneering community programs that will strengthen social and emotional bonds between parents and their children to prevent child abuse and neglect among all children living in New Mexico.

Funding from the Children's Trust Fund is for "start-up" funds to develop and support new and distinctive programs that are unavailable in a community or geographic area. The unique and innovative programs offered by contractors will address one or more of the following issues:

- Preventing the abuse and neglect of children living in New Mexico;
- Providing medical, psychological or other appropriate treatment for children who are victims of abuse or neglect;
- Developing community-based services within the State that are aimed at the prevention and treatment of child abuse and neglect.

The Children's Trust Fund programs are funded by the sale of marriage license fees, the sale of license plate fees, interest income earned from the fund and the State general fund.

New Mexico Data

- In New Mexico during the State fiscal year 2009, there were **31,088** calls alleging **37,206** incidents of suspected child abuse or neglect. From the 31,088 calls received by CYFD Statewide Central Intake (SCI), 14,654 reports were screened in and investigated.
- Of the 14,654 screened reports, there were **8,430** substantiated allegations of child abuse or neglect on **4,847** child victims. Please note multiple allegations often may exist for a single victim.
