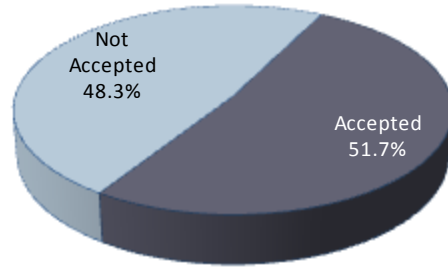




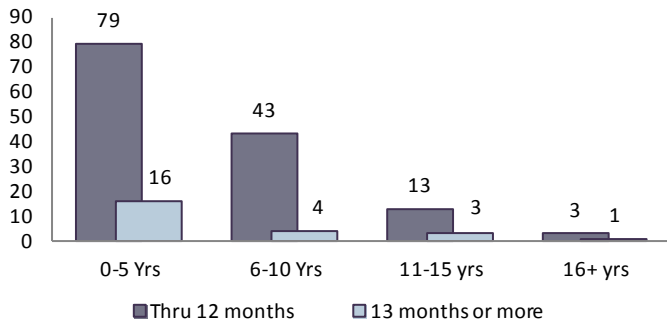
Metro Region

There are 174,674 children in Bernalillo County and 561,318 in New Mexico under the age of 19, (from the 2008 U.S. Bureau of Census round of estimates). This represents 31.1% of the state's total children under 19¹. While the county accounts for 27.8% of the state's total children under 19, Bernalillo County had 28.6% of the state's total children "in care" as of June 30, 2011, which is more than expected, based on population alone.

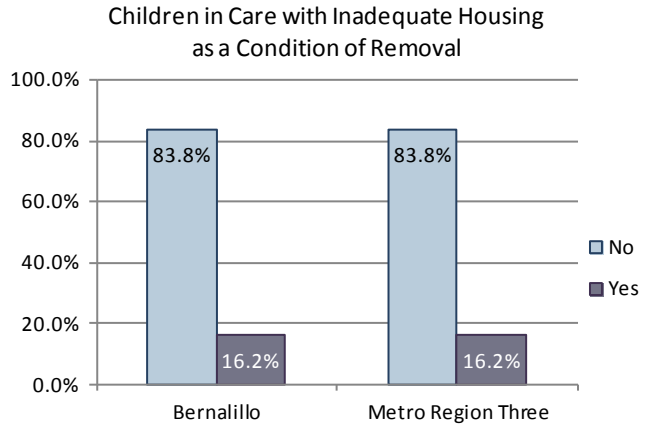

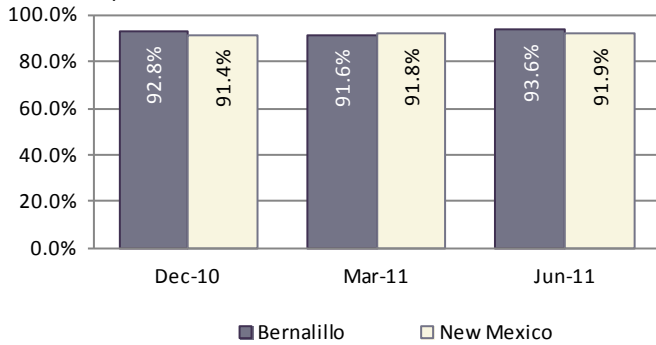

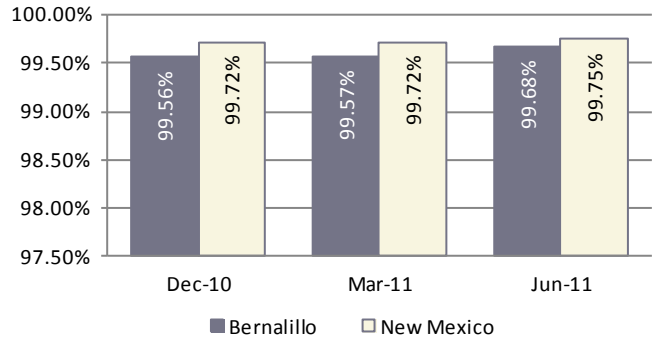
National Child Abuse and Neglect Data System (NCANDS) Safety Measures

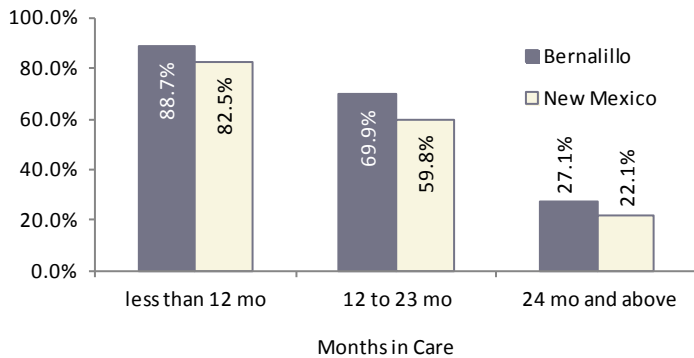
Trends of Absence of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 99.68%

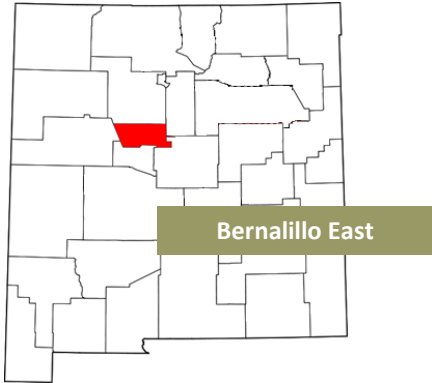
Percent of Children in Care with Incarcerated Parents as a Condition of Removal Bernalillo County

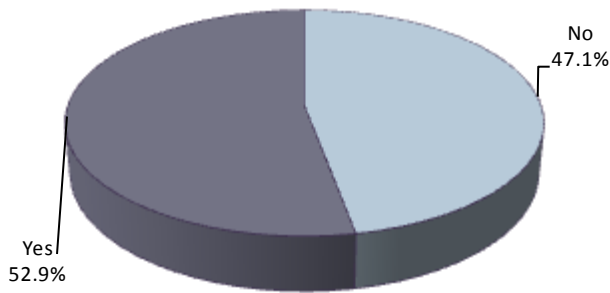

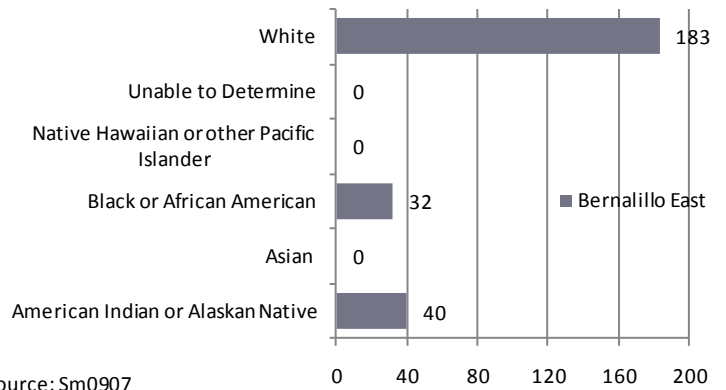
Hispanic Ethnicity in Bernalillo East

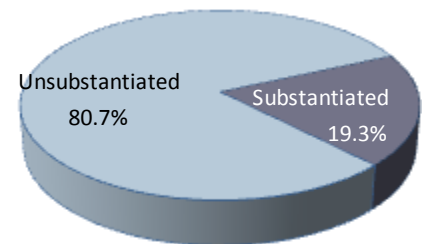

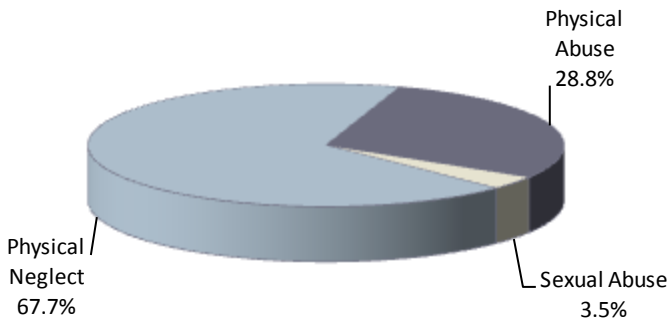

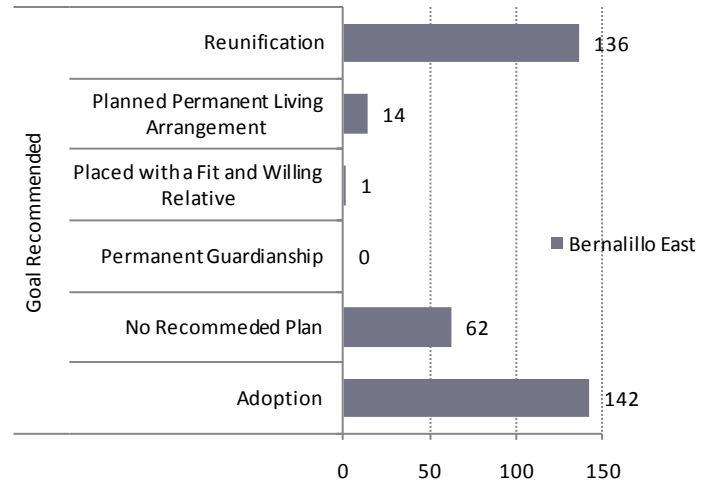

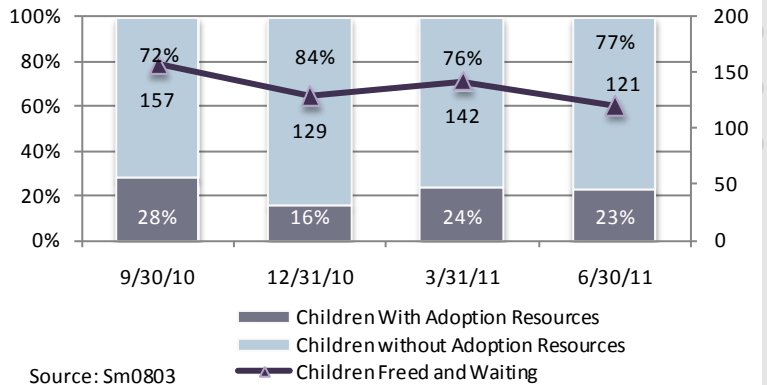

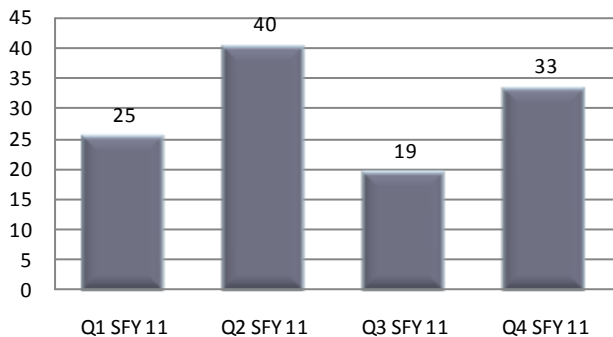

Children Freed and Waiting for Bernalillo County Point in Time Ending 9/30/10 - 6/30/11



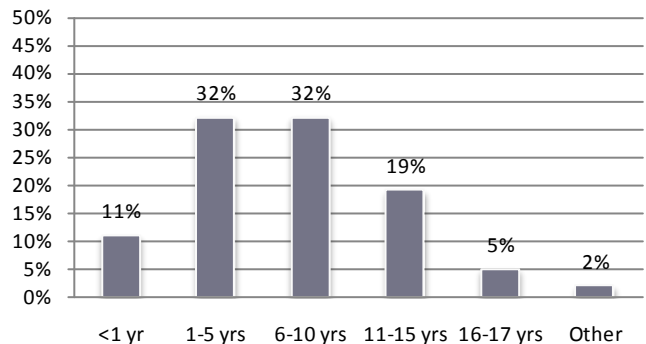

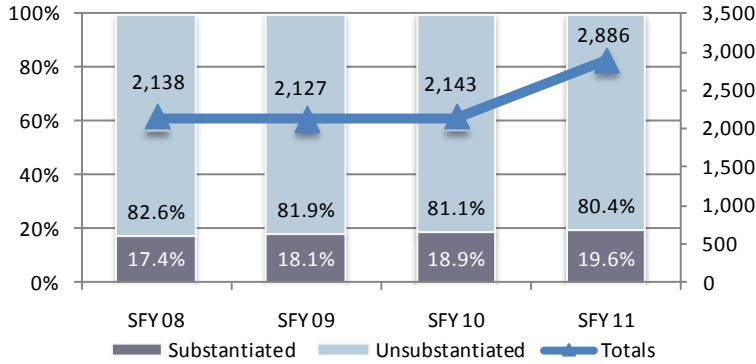
Age of Child Victims in Bernalillo SFY 2011 July 1, 2010 - June 30, 2011 N = 1,452

SFY 08 - SFY 11

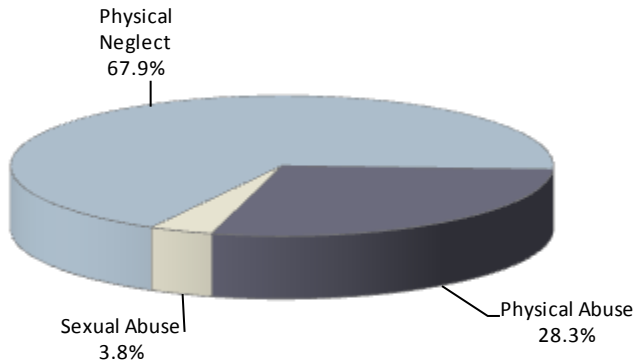

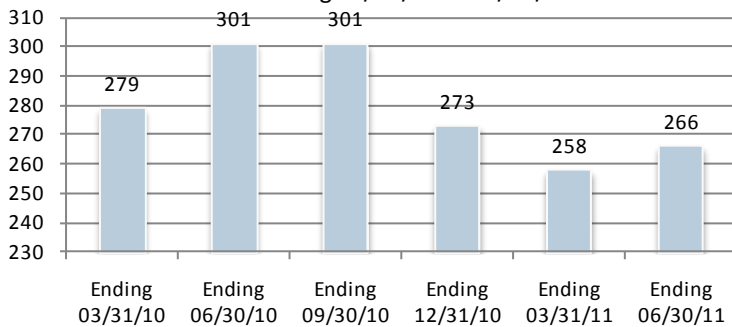
Percent of Substantiated Allegations in Bernalillo East

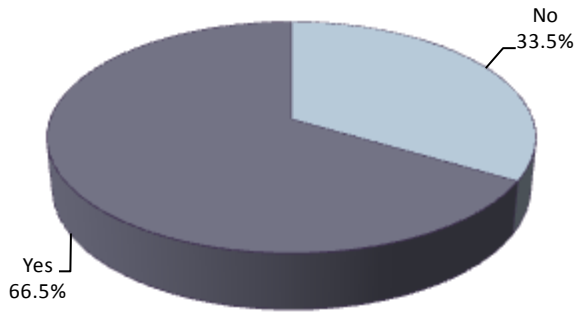

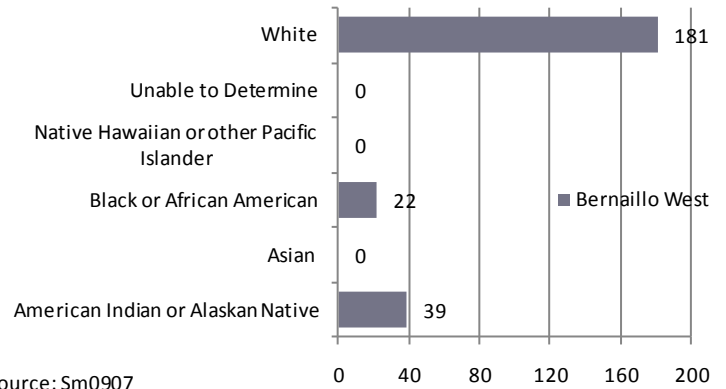

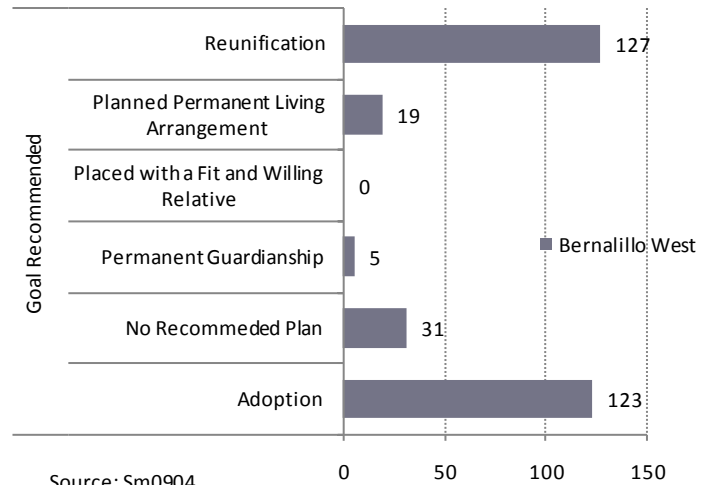

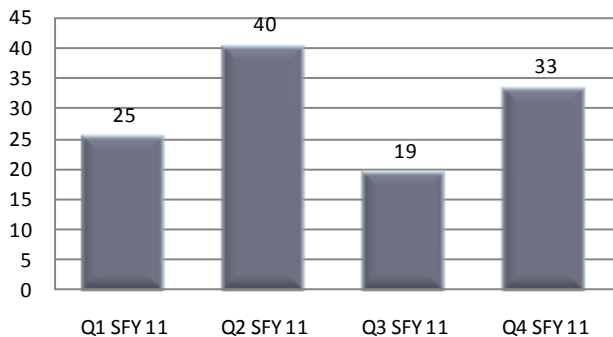

Children Freed and Waiting for Bernalillo County Point in Time Ending 9/30/10 - 6/30/11



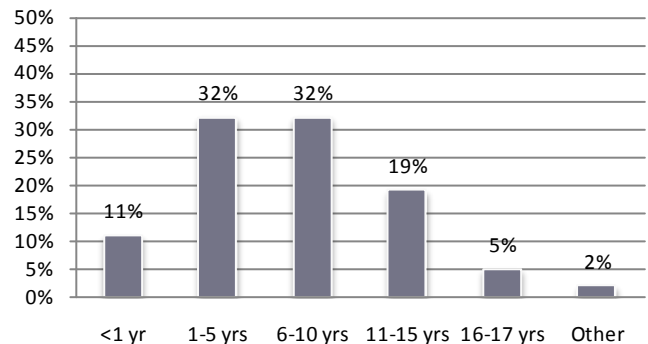

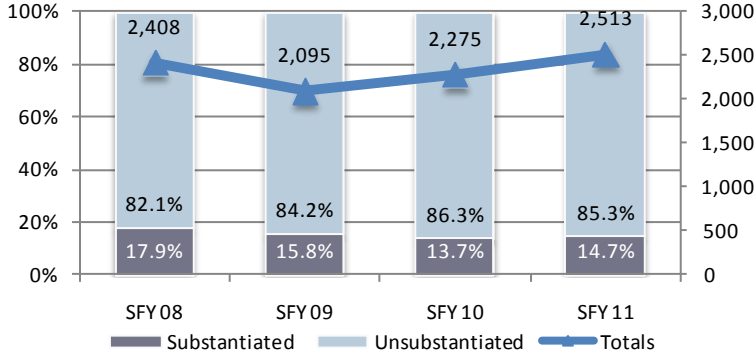
Age of Child Victims in Bernalillo SFY 2011 July 1, 2010 - June 30, 2011 N = 1,452

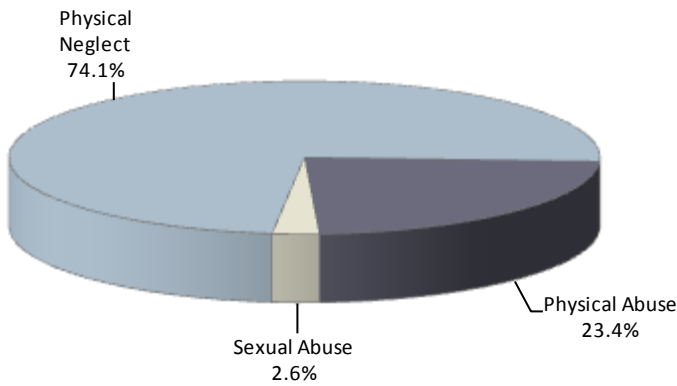

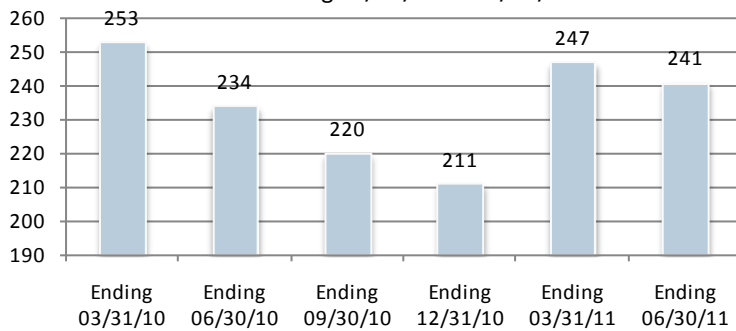
Percent of Substantiated Allegations in Bernalillo West

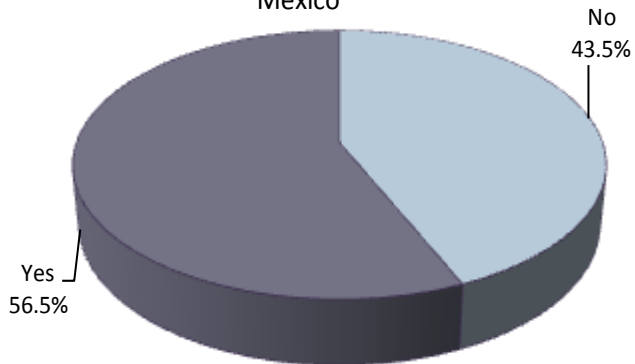

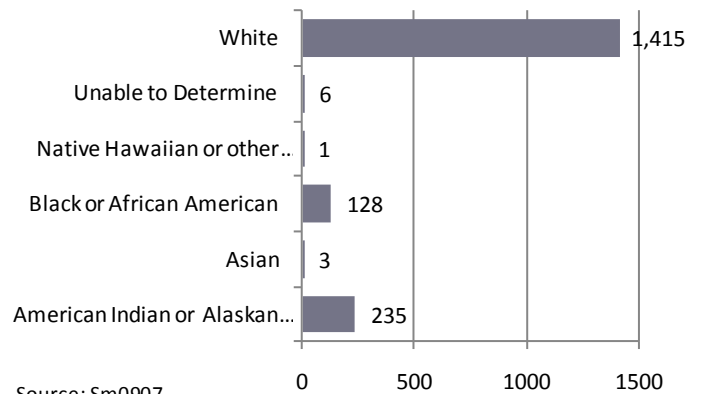

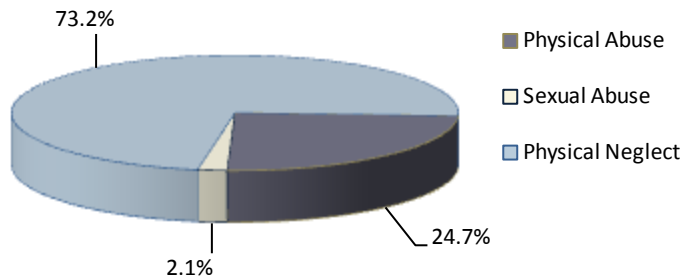

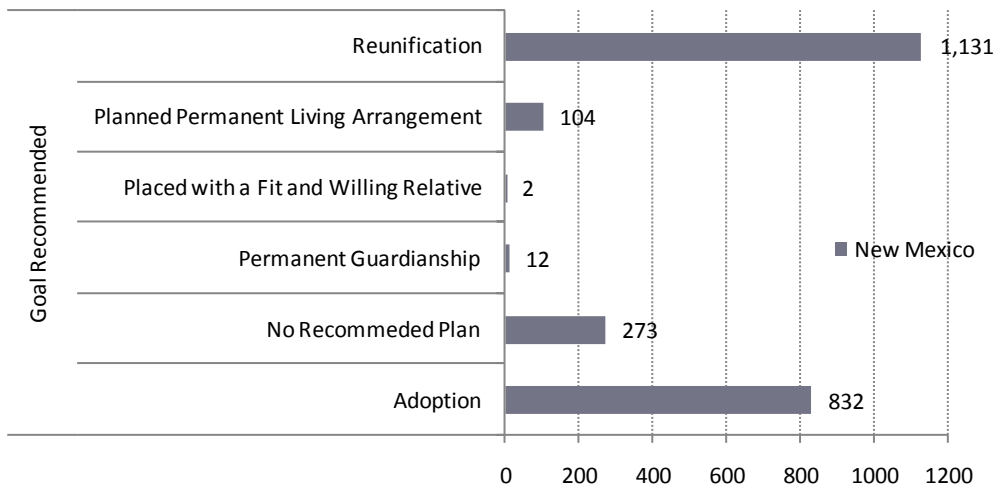

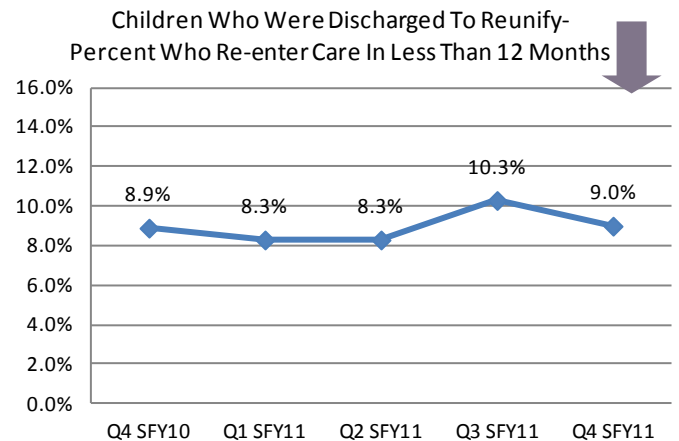
Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System (AFCARS) Permanency Measures



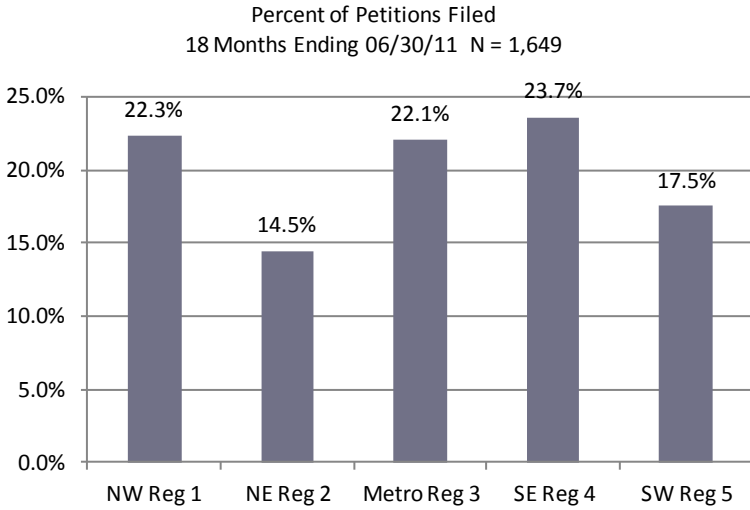

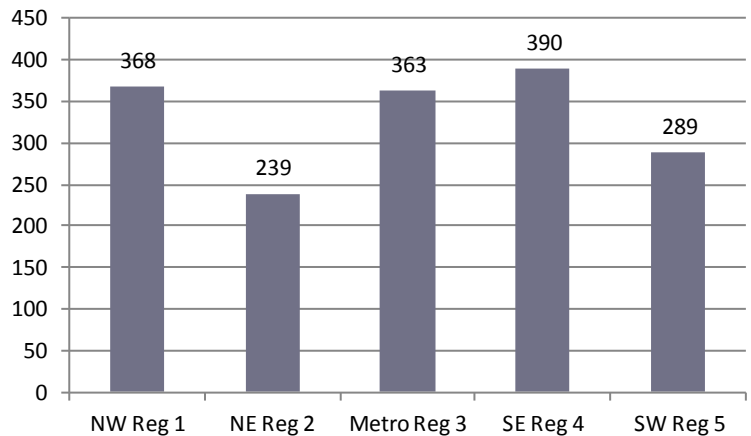

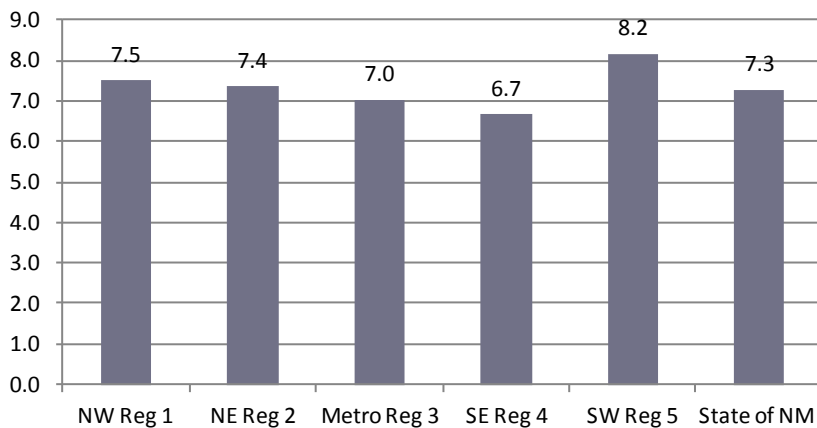
