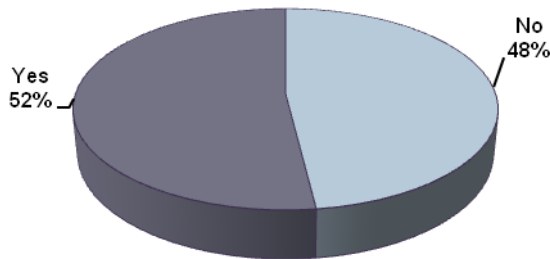

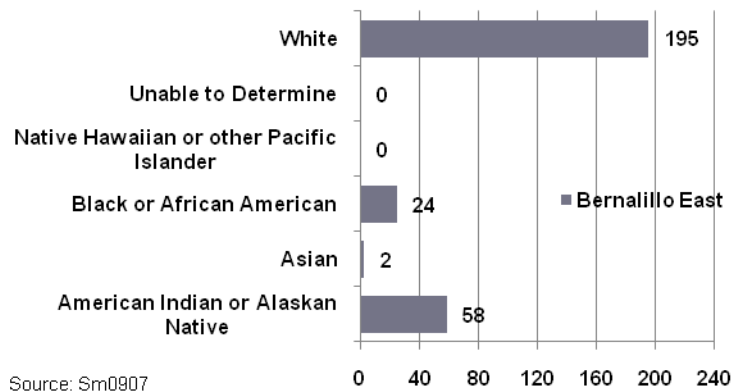

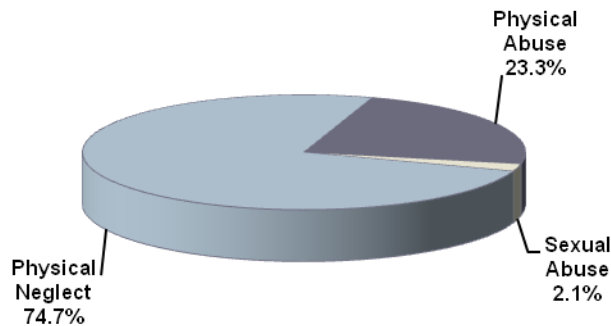

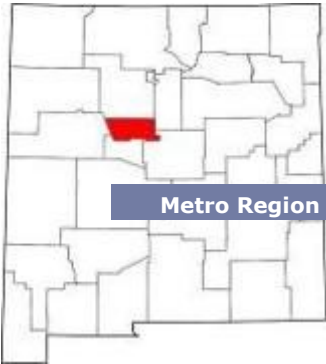

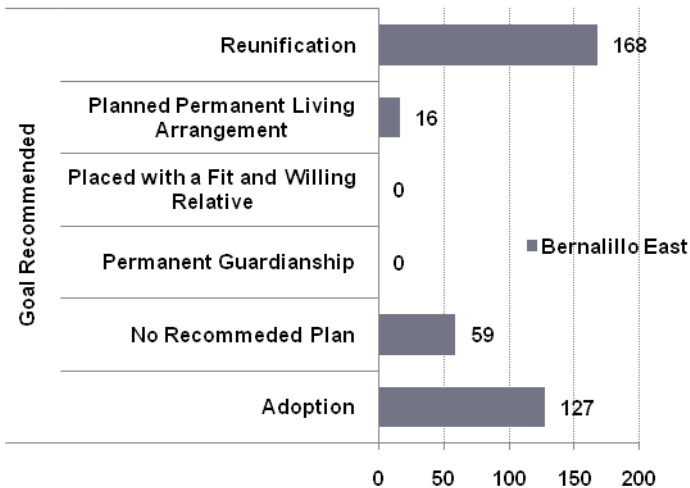

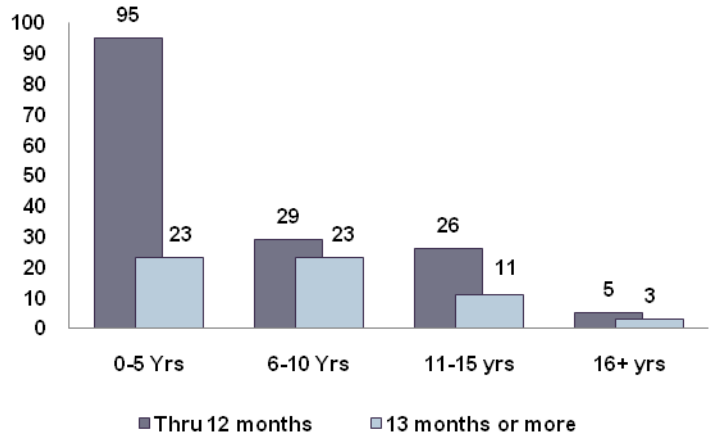

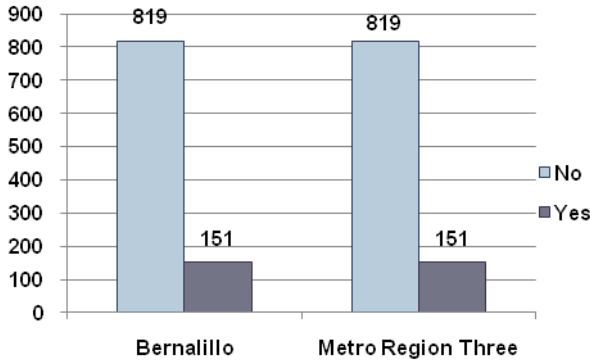
Children in Care with A Goal of Reunification Point In Time June 30, 2010 Bernalillo County N = 215

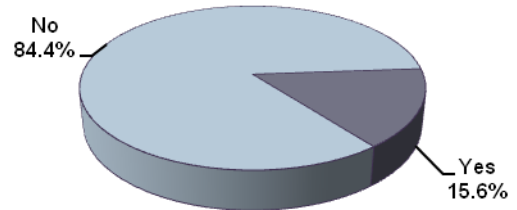
Children in Care with Incarcerated Parents as a Condition of Removal

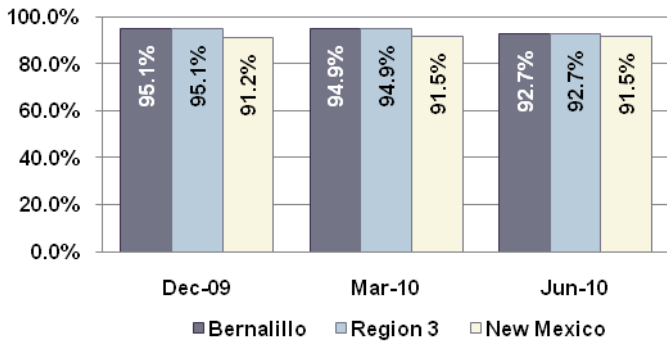
Percent of Children in Care with Incarcerated Parents as a Condition of Removal Bernalillo County

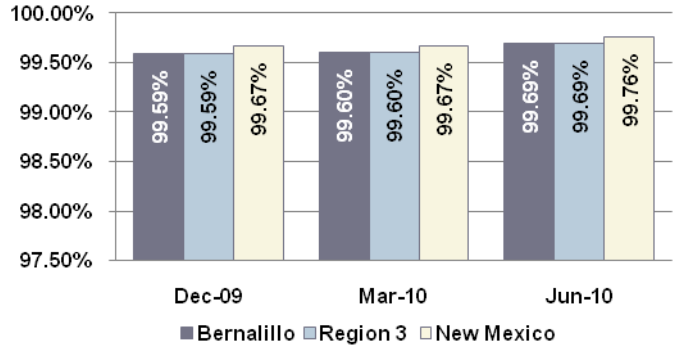

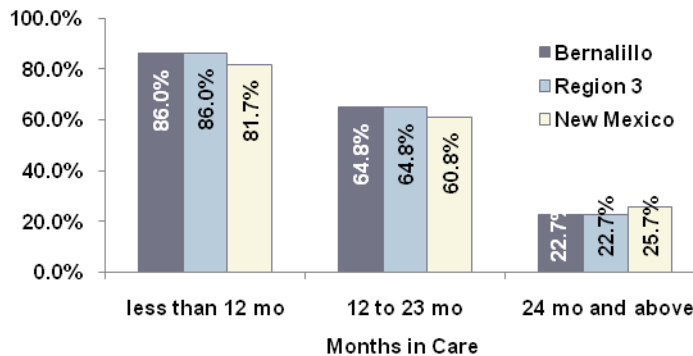
Trends of Absence of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 99.68%

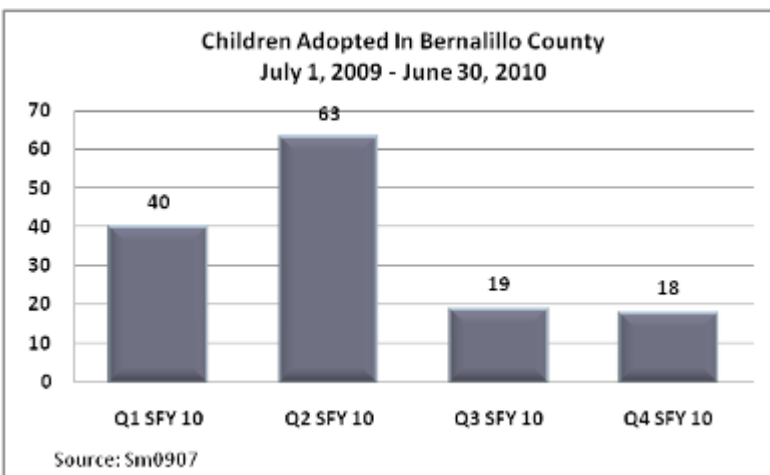
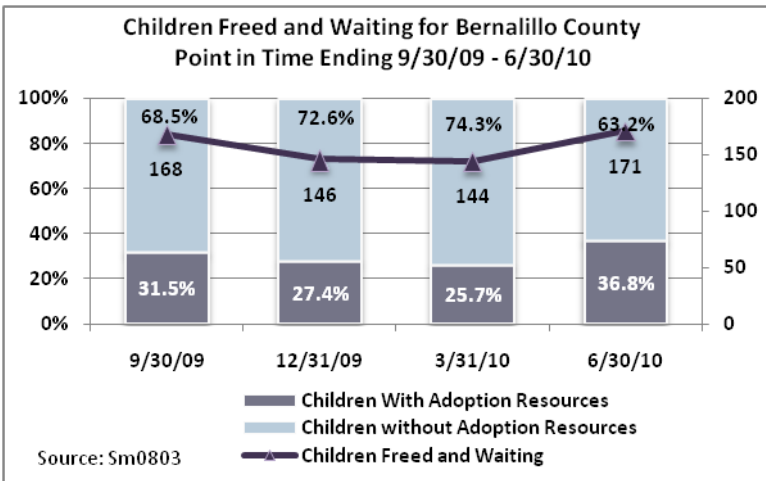
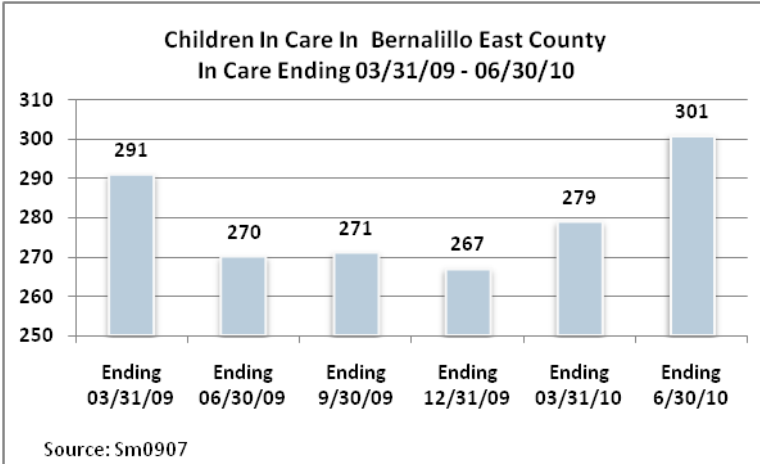
Percent of Substantiated Allegations in Bernalillo East SFY 10 July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010

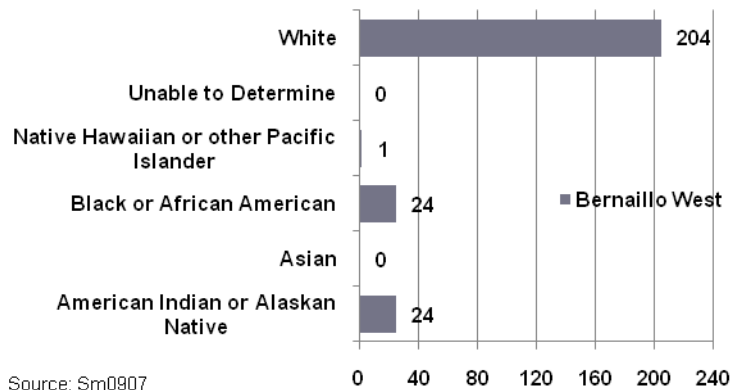

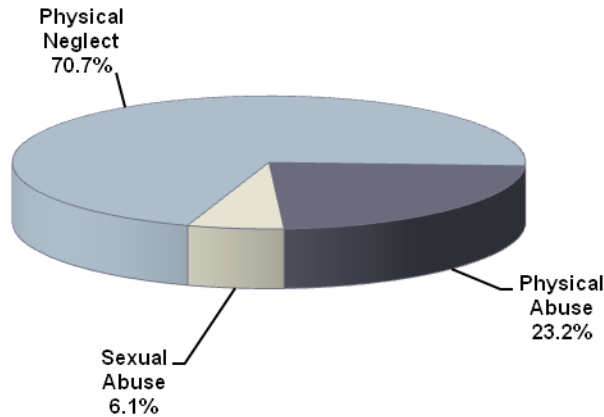

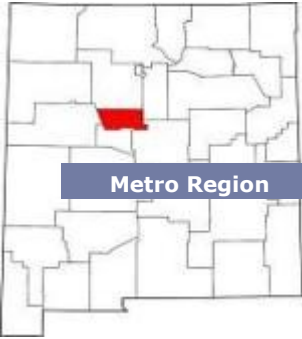

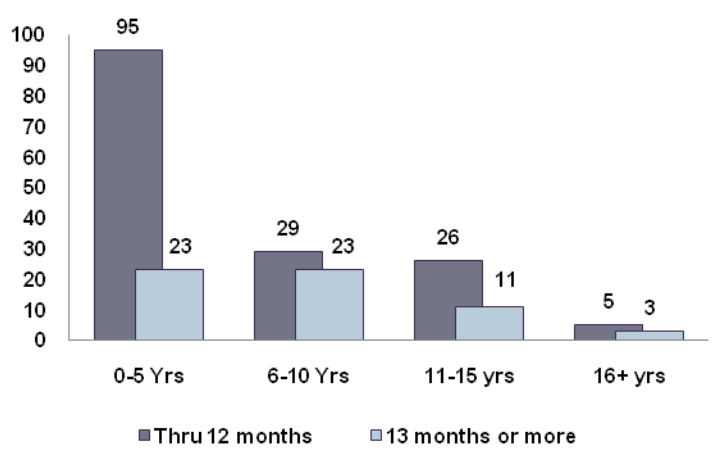

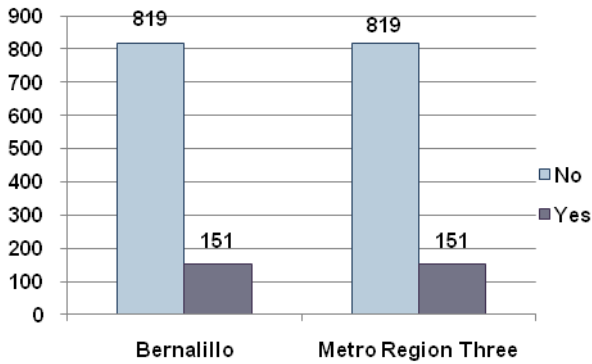

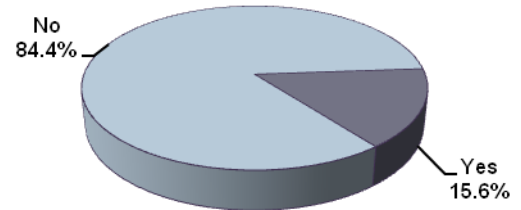
Children in Care with Incarcerated Parents as a Condition of Removal

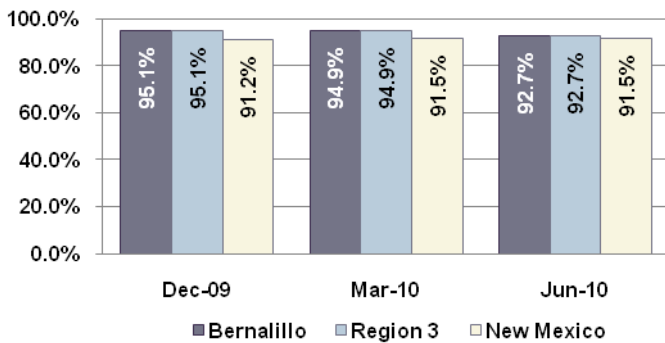
Percent of Children in Care with Incarcerated Parents as a Condition of Removal Bernalillo County

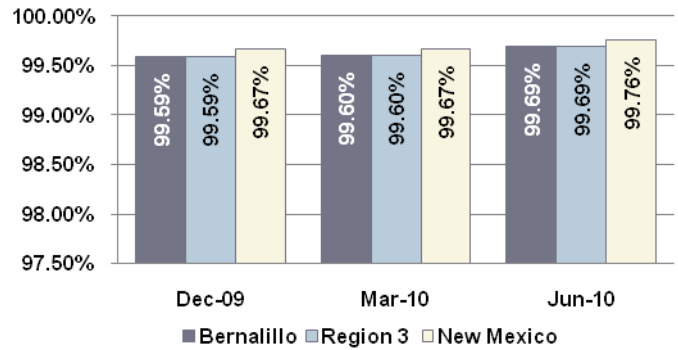

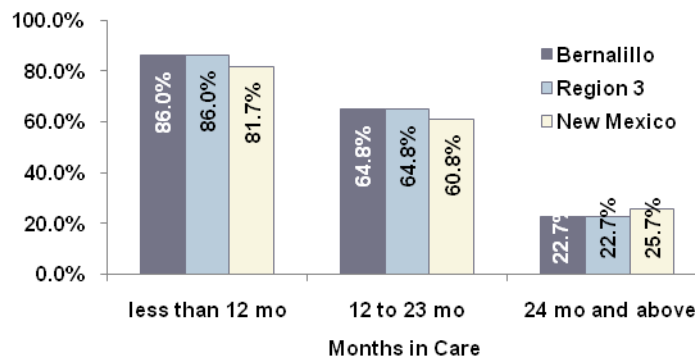
Trends of Absence of Maltreatment in Foster Care National Standard = 99.68%

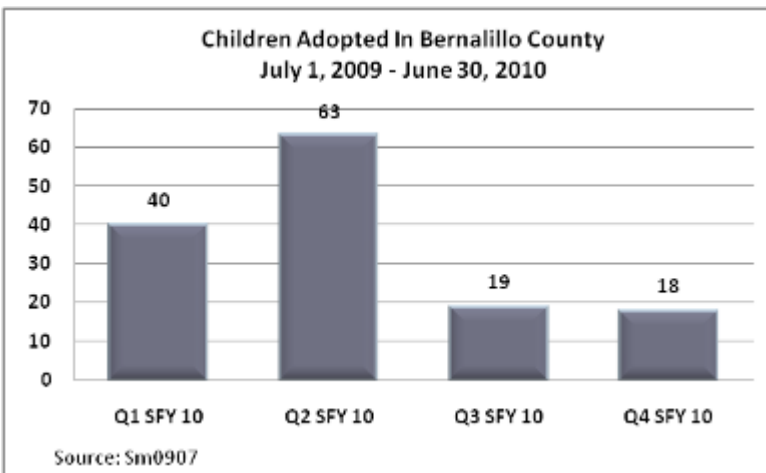
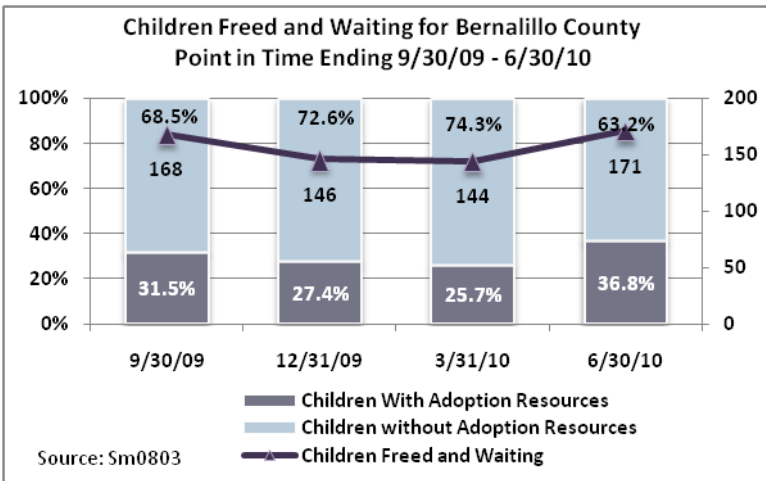
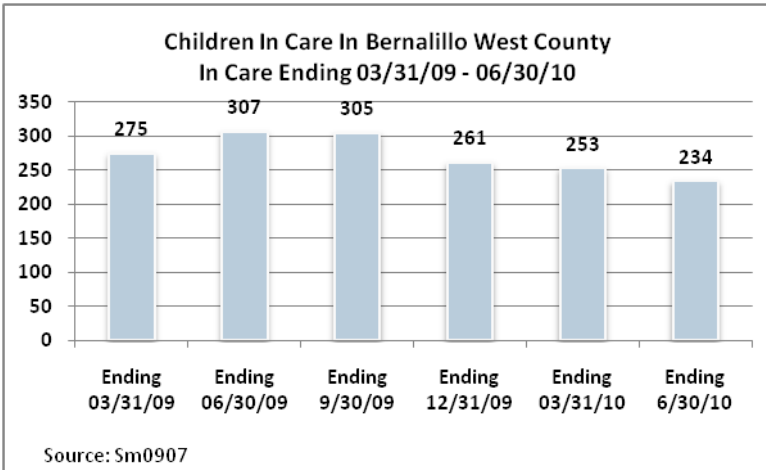
Percent of Substantiated Allegations in Bernalillo West SFY 10 July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010

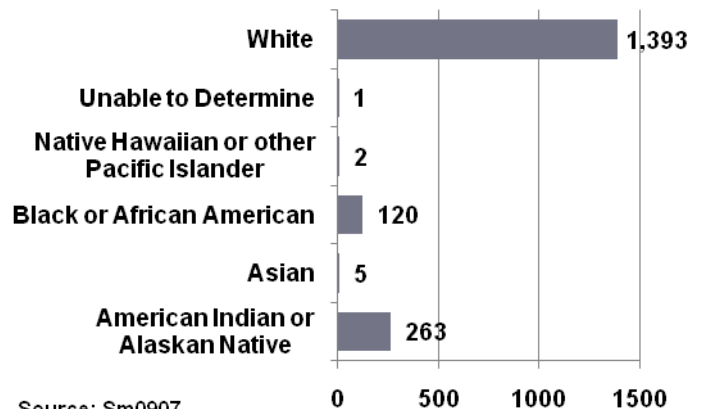

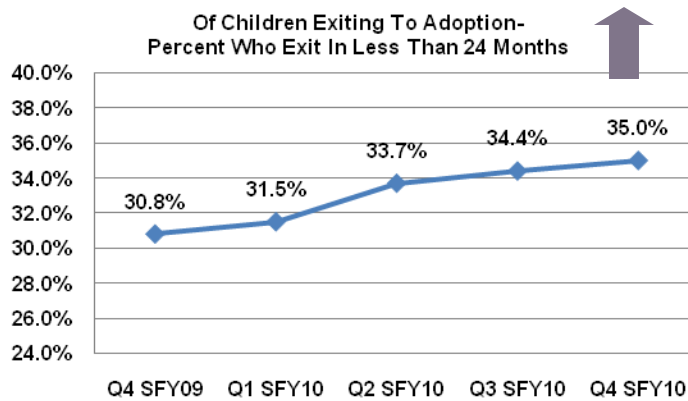

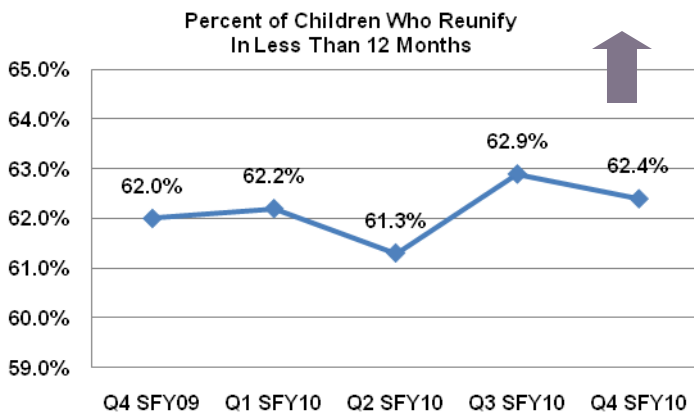

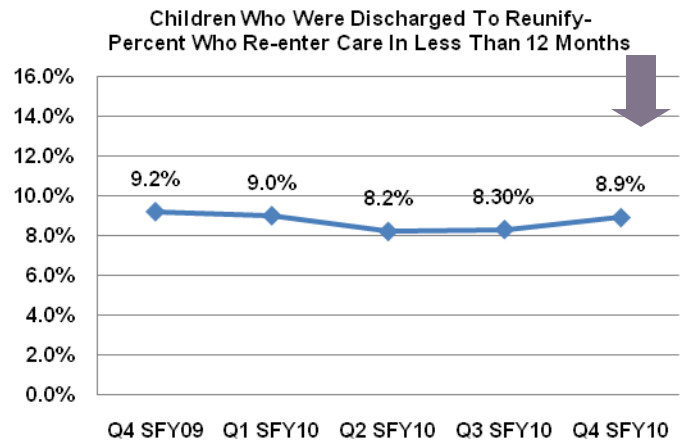

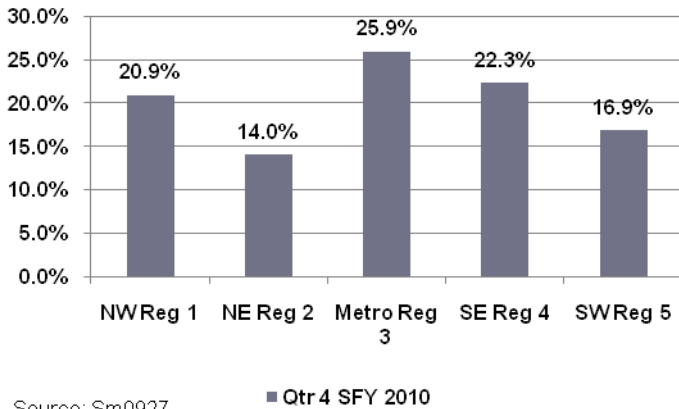
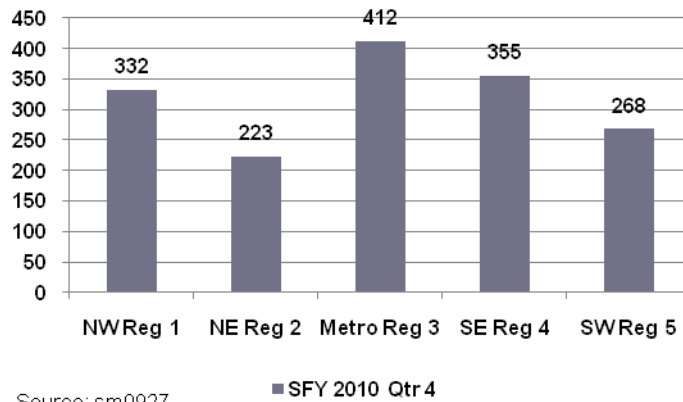
